

HOW TO PREVENT RATS AROUND YOUR HOME

RATS, YOUR NEIGHBOR MAY ALSO HAVE RATS. The only successful and permanent method of rat control is the elimination of food, shelter and rodent exclusion. Please contact the Coachella Valley Mosquito & Vector Control District (760) 342-8287 for a courtesy property inspection and recommendations for the control and prevention of roof rats.

Food and Water

- * Store pet food in sealed containers. Move food and water indoors at night. Store bulk feed 18 in. off ground and 1ft. from walls.
- * Harvest fruit and nuts as they ripen, and store properly where rodents will not be able to get them. Remove fallen fruit daily.
- * Remove all debris. Place garbage in tightly sealed trash containers.
- * Repair leaks in faucets, drip irrigation and sprinkler systems. Avoid puddles from refrigeration condensation.

Shelter

- * Store outdoor items (hay, firewood, lumber) on shelves at least 18 in. off the ground and 1ft. from walls.
- * Reduce or remove ground cover, dense ivy and other similar ornamentals.
- Trim vegetation and trees 2-3 ft. away from buildings. Remove old growth from palm trees. Remove all debris.
- * Inspect outdoor storage sheds periodically.
